The Financial Report was reviewed with a motion made, seconded and approved to accept.

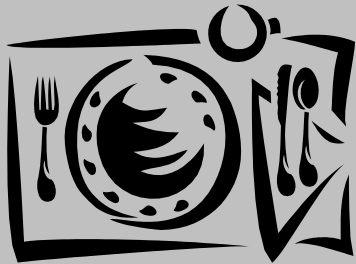

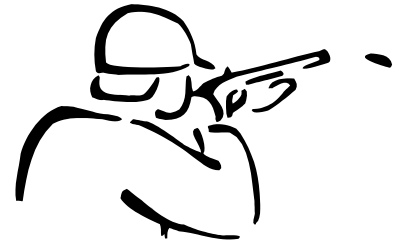
